

Comment Dominator Pro *Script-Pack*

OLSP pays you for leaving genuine, useful comments through Comment Dominator Pro — no recruiting, no selling. The catch: generic one-liners ("Nice!" / "Love this!") get ignored or rejected fast, and spammy repeated comments can get you flagged. This pack gives you 30 ready-to-adapt comment openers across 6 situations, so you can stay consistent without staring at a blank box every time.

3 Rules Before You Start Commenting

- ✓ Always swap in one specific detail from the actual post — a name, a number, a phrase they used. A template used word-for-word every time is what gets accounts flagged.
- ✓ Add a genuine reaction or a short follow-up thought, not just a compliment. Comments that add something read as real.
- ✓ Spread comments across the day instead of firing them all in one 5-minute burst. Natural pacing matters more than volume.

1. Reacting To A Win / Result Post

Someone shares a sale, a milestone, or a screenshot.

OPENER A That's a great number for [timeframe they mentioned] — what changed for you this week vs last?

OPENER B Screenshots like this are exactly why I stuck with this. Congrats — did [specific thing they mentioned] make the biggest difference?

OPENER C Love seeing this. Which part of the process felt hardest before it clicked for you?

OPENER D This is proof it works if you stay consistent. How long were you at it before this happened?

OPENER E Solid milestone. Are you planning to push for [next logical goal] next, or focus on repeating this first?

2. Reacting To A Question / "I'm Stuck" Post

Someone's asking for help or venting about being stuck.

OPENER A I hit the same wall with [topic]. What finally helped me was slowing down on [specific step] — worth a look?

OPENER B You're not alone in this — this part trips up a lot of people. Have you checked [relevant training/section] yet?

OPENER C This is more common than you'd think. What have you already tried so far?

OPENER D Totally normal at this stage. What does your current setup for [topic] look like?

OPENER E I remember feeling exactly this. Once I fixed [specific thing], it got a lot easier — happy to share what I did.

3. Reacting To A Training / Live Session Recap

Someone posts notes or a takeaway from a webinar or lesson.

OPENER A Good breakdown. The part about [specific point] was the one that stood out to me too.

OPENER B Thanks for summarizing — I missed the live one. Did they mention anything about [related topic]?

OPENER C That's a great takeaway. I'd add that [related detail] matters just as much once you start applying it.

OPENER D Solid notes. Are you planning to apply [specific point] this week?

OPENER E This is worth saving. What was your biggest "aha" from the session?

4. Reacting To A Mindset / Motivational Post

Someone shares a lesson learned, a struggle, or encouragement.

OPENER A Needed to read this today, honestly. What made you realize [the point they made]?

OPENER B This mindset shift is underrated. How long did it take before it actually stuck for you?

OPENER C Real talk. This is the part most people skip and then wonder why they're stuck.

OPENER D Appreciate you being honest about this — it helps more than another "everything's easy" post.

OPENER E This is a good reminder. Are you applying this to [specific area] right now?

5. Reacting To A New Member Introduction

Someone just joined and posted a quick intro.

OPENER A Welcome! What made you decide to start with [what they mentioned about themselves]?

OPENER B Glad you're here. First goal I'd focus on if I were you: finish the Bootcamp — it's a quick win.

OPENER C Great intro. What's the main result you're hoping for in the next 30 days?

OPENER D Welcome aboard — this community will save you a lot of trial and error if you stay active in it.

OPENER E Good to have you. Anything specific you're already stuck on that I can point you toward?

6. Reacting To A Tool / Resource Share

Someone shares a tool, template, or workflow tip.

OPENER A Didn't know about this one — how are you using it inside your [specific workflow] right now?

OPENER B This is genuinely useful, thanks for sharing. Does it integrate with [related tool] at all?

OPENER C Saving this. How long did it take you to set up?

OPENER D Appreciate you posting this instead of keeping it to yourself — that's rare in this space.

OPENER E Good find. Have you noticed any downside to it so far?

How to use this pack: pick 1-2 openers per category, tweak the bracketed detail to match the actual post, and rotate through categories across the day. Aim for quality over volume — a handful of specific, thoughtful comments outperforms dozens of copy-pasted ones, both for approval and for your reputation in the community.
